



Make a hedgehog pen holder

Keep your pens and pencils tidy in this colourful hedgehog.

What you need

- Large cardboard plates (22–24cm diameter)
- A glue brush
- PVA glue
- Coloured tissue paper
- Scissors
- A4 thin card or thick paper
- A ruler
- Sticky tape
- A pencil
- Coloured card

TOP TIP

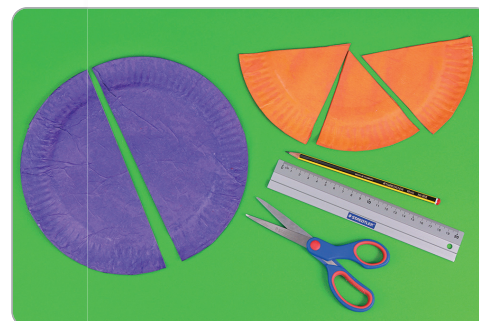
Glue two plates together to make a double layer if the cardboard is thin. If you don't have cardboard plates, cut two 23cm circles from thin card.



1 To make the body, brush glue over a cardboard plate, stick some tissue paper on top then leave it to dry.



2 For the head, cut a plate in half, brush with glue and cover with tissue. Take care to paste down any tissue around the edges. Leave to dry.



3 Cut the whole plate in half to make two semi-circles for the body. Cut each half plate into three equal (60°) wedge shapes as shown.



4 Cut the A4 card into four equal sections, then cut one piece in half to make five pieces. Roll these into 3cm diameter tubes. Tape the edges.



5 Glue the tubes in the middle of a body. Put the other body piece on top. Pinch the ends of the body together and stick with glue.



6 Cut a zigzag on two wedge pieces for the head, and cut the last piece into prickles. Glue on with eyes and nose. Add strips of card for feet.
